## 1<sup>st</sup> Day:

### Strolling around the city with Bach`s wife Anna Magdalena

Get to know the famous sights of Leipzig and important places of the city where the famous composer Johann Sebastian Bach worked and lived for 27 years on a walking tour through the city centre with Bach`s wife Anna Magdalena.

It`s Leipzig where Bach wrote his most important works. In 1723 he signed the contract in the Old City Hall and became *director musices* of the city and choirmaster of St. Thomas and St. Nicholas, that means he became church, city and university music director at the same time.

On our theme tour you may walk in the footsteps of Bach in Leipzig and visit the Old City Hall, St. Thomas and St. Nicholas Churches as well as other relevant places and get to know many interesting anecdotes about Bach`s life and work in Leipzig.

### Auerbachs Keller: „On Goethe´s and Faust´s trail“

Leipzig`s most famous restaurant has been welcoming visitors since 1530. Featured in Goethe`s most famous work Faust, diners can enjoy a unique atmosphere. In addition to the menu`s culinary delights, guests are fascinated by the sense of history which comes to life in the basement restaurant. On entering the Mädler Passage arcade, guests are greeted by bronze statues of Mephisto and Faust created by painter and sculptor Mathieu Molitor. By the way, touching Faust`s statue is supposed to bring you luck.

After a short guided tour (about 30 minutes) of the Historical Wine Bars and the Big Cellar the dish of the day is served in our Big Cellar and you will get Mephisto`s "sweet" chocolate thaler to take away.

## Mendelssohn House

The Mendelssohn House in Leipzig has been preserved as the last and sole private residence of the composer Felix Mendelssohn Bartholdy. It is of great historical and cultural importance. Built in 1844, in the style of Late Classicism the house is an important witness of its time and it preserves much of the original building and information about its most prominent occupier who lived with his family on the 1st floor beginning in 1845 and died here November 4 in 1847.

Today, Mendelssohn's flat is a museum in honour of this brilliant German composer, virtuoso and conductor who was also a very good painter and active in the field of cultural and educational policy. Experience the flat as an authentic place where many progressive ideas for the European musical life and the world of thought came from.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Day:

### Day trip to FREYBURG – Grape growing around Saale & Unstrut rivers

On a tour through the Saale and Unstrut valley you will learn about the history of local wine-growing, a trade which stretches back over a thousand years.

The Winzervereinigung Freyburg-Unstrut eG combines to perfection over 1,000 years of experience in wine-growing with the latest cellar techniques and the highest quality criteria, resulting in wines which are popular far beyond the boundaries of this region because of their tangy lightness, delicately spicy bouquet and the freshness typical of this area.

After a cellar tour you'll enjoy a tasting of 3 different wines and a rustic-style "Winzervesper" ("wine-grower's dinner" = lunch buffet with cheese, ham, cucumber and egg salad, tomato mozzarella, bread & butter).

After lunch you will be enchanted by the medieval atmosphere of the legendary Neuenburg Castle, the biggest castle of the Thuringia landgraves.

Or (instead of Neuenburg Castle) enjoy a visit to Naumburg:

Naumburg, the old commercial town and the centre of a wine-growing region welcomes visitors from a far with the four towers of its cathedral. Naumburg is one of the most beautiful towns in central Germany. In the Middle Ages the cathedral town had its period of prosperity as an important fair and trade centre. Today impressive old town houses, the town fortifications, the magnificent market square and the world-famous cathedral all bear witness to this rich and colorful history.

In Naumburg you will enjoy a guided tour through the cathedral which houses the 12 world-famous sculptures of its founders by an unknown Naumburg artist.
